Art

Make your own 'Earth' mask (just like our character in the video) with a piece of card cut into a circle. The teacher can cut a hole out in the middle for your face to come through. Tie a string or elastic around it by threading it through a punctured hole on each side, to keep your mask in place. You can even colour in your mask to show the different layers of the earth. Now do the Earthquake Shake!

PE/Dance

Follow our instructional video to learn how to do the 'Earthquake Shake' dance. Have a go at creating your own 'Earthquake Shake' moves based on the movement of the earth, the plates or even the oceans during an earthquake.

English

Create a safety poster giving instructions about what to do in the event of an earthquake. You could include diagrams or pictures in your work.

History/Geography

Create a timeline to show earthquakes from around the world since you were born. Label with the date, location and the Richter scale score. How many earthquakes have happened in the country where you live? Is there a part of the world where earthquakes happen more often? Explore why you think this might be.

Use a map to highlight where the fault lines are across the world by showing them with a bright colour.
